As the wind became more gentle, it became harder to overcome the current. The news: thirteen Sidewinders and a start of our own.

The hosts and hostesses had a fabulous snack bar, for one thing more kinds of cake than a county fair. There was a party with plenty of food in the warehouse. And plenty of friendly manpower to carry boats. The D-J of a local radio station was in the races, second time afloat. The water was deep enough as promised. NILS DEMAR was first for a plaque. Henry Ramm was second. Carol Park was third. And Bill Millar was all over the place making sure we felt welcome at his Hanover regatta.

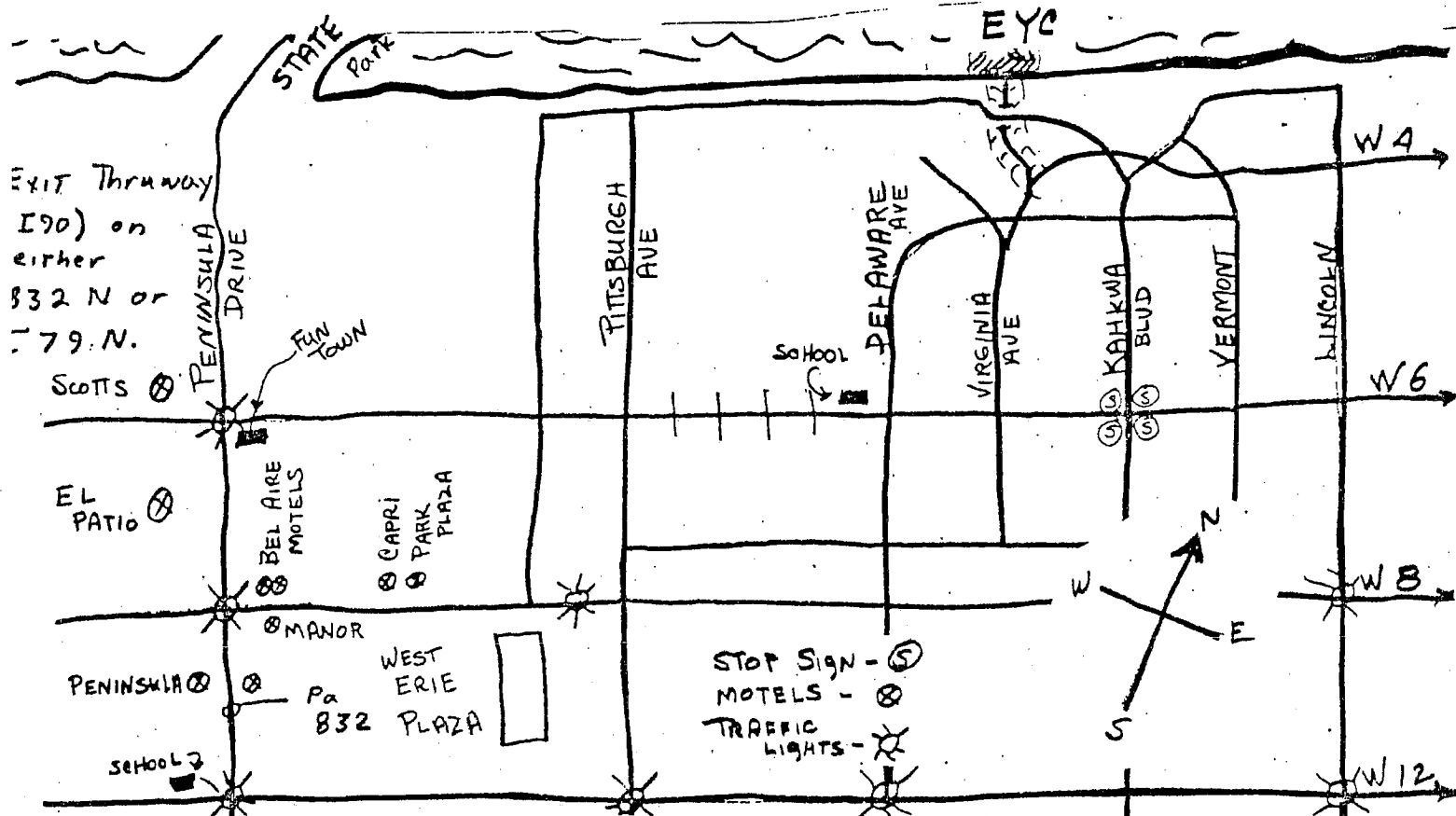

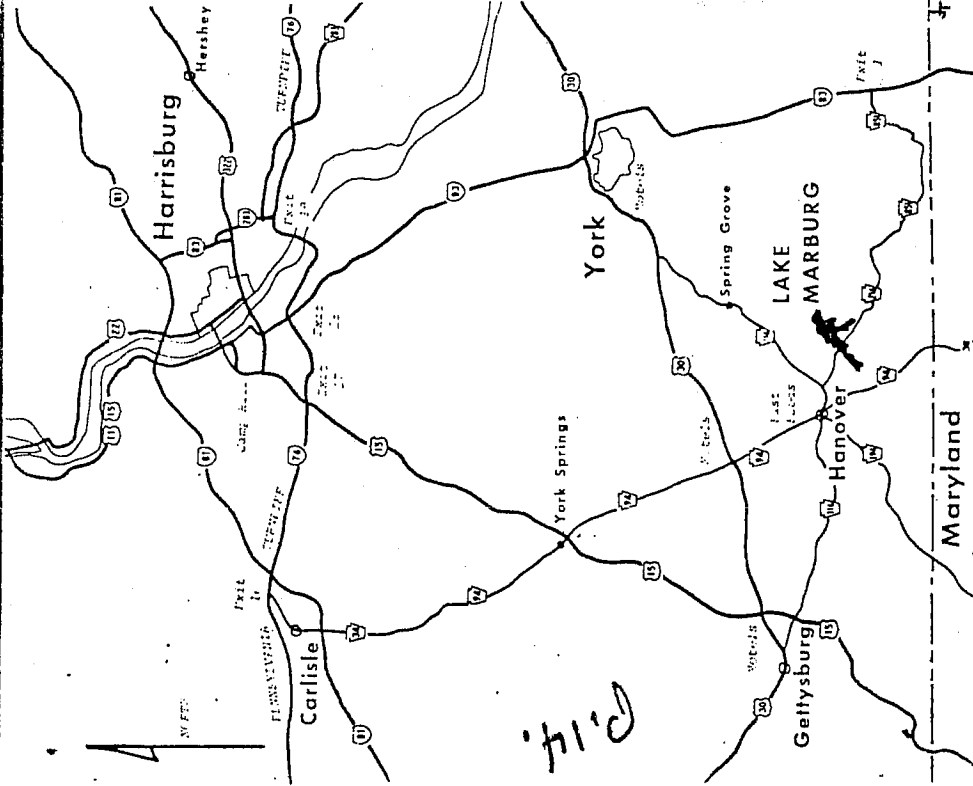

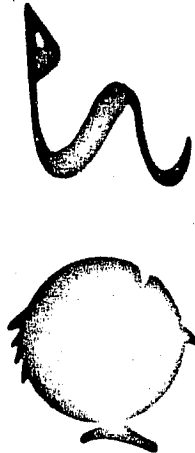
